2nd October



Gemtree Vineyards is owned and run by third generation grapegrowers, dedicated to producing iconic wines of the highest quality from their McLaren Vale vineyards which since 2008 have been farmed 100% biodynamically. Mike Brown pushes the boundaries of experimentation with biodynamic wines and alternative winemaking practices.

Golding Wines is a small and dynamic family owned winery situated at Lenswood, high in the picturesque Adelaide Hills of South Australia. Samuel's Gorge is situated on the southern lip of the Onkaparinga River National Park in the McLaren Vale. The wines are driven by their texture with a common rustic nature that supports the fruit drive.

Yangarra Estate is located in the Blewitt Springs sub region of the McLaren Vale and specialises in Mediterranean varieties grown mainly as bush vines. The wine philosophy is built around the Estate's original, dry-farmed bush vines planted in 1946. With a focus on minimal intervention in viticulture and winemaking, Yangarra produce wines that are the most brilliant possible reflection of the Estate's unique terroir and provide a profound sense of place.

13th November



Situated in the Limestone Coast of Australia the Padthaway Estate winery combines the grace of a classic Australian woolshed with a simple functional winery, capable of processing high quality fruit into fine wine. With an aim to bridge the gap between New World and Old World practices Murray Street wines are, on the whole, earthy and structured to express the vibrancy of fruit for which the Barossa Valley is famous.

The unique combination of the Adelaide Hills' chilly climate, diverse soils and natural elevation all play a major part in making the Bridgewater Mill wines so special. Established by Brian Croser in 1976, Petaluma have established a huge reputation, primarily for their Chardonnay from the Piccadilly Valley, but more recently for Riesling from the Clare Valley and a Cabernet/Merlot blend from the Coonawarra.

11th December
